<u>Introduction - Short description of the NEWS in MAP project</u>

NEWS in MAP is a three-year strategic partnership project funded by the European Commission's Erasmus+ program that fosters self-leadership and provides educational solutions geared to increase the chances of achieving successful independent and or dependent musical careers.

<u>C3 – "Lets Create our Future with Music"</u>

The Student training "Lets Create our Future with Music" was created and hosted by the Yaşar University contingent of the NEWS in MAP project. It took place online between the 18th and 22nd of October, 2021 with a preliminary online meeting on the 15th of October, 2021.

The main objective was for non experts to create the design and content for a personal website template that would help a musician promote his or her online presence.


The website design was broken down into four different areas of research.

able to share specialized knowledge with their original group members.

- 1) Promotional Content based on personal and professional data and self assessment.
- 2) Website Design.
- 3) Social Media Promotion.
- 4) Feedback

To achieve this, a Jigsaw cooperative learning model was used in which the twenty participating students, from four different countries (Ireland, Italy, Cyprus and Turkey) were placed in five "Original" groups of mixed nationality, age and gender. The original groups met and had an initial meeting and work session on their website. Each was assigned an area of expertise based on the four areas mentioned above. For the second meeting, the members of the original groups were split up and placed into four "Specialist" groups, created according to the fours areas of specialization. This allowed the specialists to discuss and research their area of expertise only so that when they returned to their original groups they would be

The sequence is represented in the diagram below:



All the research and work in creating the website was done by the students themselves with limited input from teacher mentors that were present at every session and served only as guides. All work done outside of the meetings was undertaken voluntarily by the students alone.

The quality of their achievement depended entirely on the quality of the group effort where the group is as important as the individual and the individual is as important as the group. Cooperation was key.

The learning experience was designed to have the following educational outcomes.

- The student become the teachers.
- The students deliver a real final product.
- The student learns self-directed and independent research.
- Individuals are responsible for themselves and their groups.
- Students create something as opposed to learn about something.
- Students experience self-discovery.
- Students gain actionable skills and knowledge.
- Students learn to communicate constructively and effectively.

In the final meeting, the groups presented their projects.

All expectations were exceeded. Instead of producing a template alone, all four groups presented fully-functional websites, some for fictitious personas, some for their fellow students.




4.5 Average rating



How would you rate the level of cooperation within your Specialist group?



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If you had no prior knowledge of, or experience in Website design, would you now be in a better position to create a website of your own?


