My name is Luca de Matteis, a twenty-three young composer born and raised in Naples, now studying at Santa Celilia's Conservatory in Rome.

In my home town I made scientific studies in high school and then attended the course of Materials science and engineering at the Federico II University for two years. This could give me the chance to propose and share with everyone my own point of view, helping people experience themselves and world around us with music the same way it has been for me for all these years.
